

The website thereflection.io (hereafter referred to as "the Site") uses cookies. A cookie is a string of text created by a server and stored on the hard drive of your computer or other device used to access the Internet (smartphone, tablet) before being transmitted on subsequent visits by the user.

Cookies allow the collection of information about a user's navigation on the site, such as storing language preferences and offering these preferences during subsequent visits, simplifying the use of websites.

Cookies can be stored on your device permanently and have varying durations (referred to as persistent cookies) or they may disappear after closing the browser or have a limited lifespan (referred to as session cookies).

Cookies can be set by the sites you visit (referred to as first-party cookies) or by other websites (referred to as third-party cookies).

The Site uses first-party cookies, third-party cookies, and other similar technologies as described below.

Navigation and Functional Cookies:

The Site uses session and persistent first-party cookies to ensure secure and efficient internet browsing, as well as to enhance the services provided. Functional cookies improve the browsing experience.

Analytical Cookies:

The Site uses cookies from Google Analytics and clarity.microsoft.com to collect information about site usage.
